ince The James opened in the fall of 2011, it's become common for guests at this independent downtown boutique to simply remark, "Man, Saskatoon really needed this." The property, designed by Calgarian Michael Shugarman, raises the stakes with rich materials—loads of onyx, marble and walnut. And your \$220 stay includes a full-on breakfast with a chef-attended buffet and made-to-order Bennies. Feeling plush? Check into the 12th-floor penthouse, a 1,600-square-foot beauty with river views, fireplace and two balconies. It's the only thing like it in the province.

the hotel; it stretches for

STEAL THE LOOK
